Directions to Car-Dun-AI Training Club

From the east, take I-90 to the Route 47 exit. Go north on Route 47 approximately 3.7 miles to Oakcrest Drive and turn left (known as Algonquin Road to the right). Go 0.2 miles on Oakcrest to Wolf Drive and turn left.

From the west, take I-90 to the Route 20 exit. Go west (left) 1.6 miles to Harmony Road. Turn right on Harmony Road and drive 3.7 miles to the stop sign, then turn left to stay on Harmony Road. Drive to the next stop sign and turn right (Main Street). Drive 1.4 miles on Main Street to Route 47 and turn left. Go .4 miles north on Route 47 to Oakcrest Drive and turn left. (Algonquin Road to the right). Drive approximately 0.2 miles to Wolf Drive and turn left.

From the Host Hotel, turn left onto IL-64. Go west to Burlington Road approximately 5 miles. Turn right on Burlington Road to Route 47 approximately 5 miles Go north on Route 47 approximately 13.7 miles to Oakcrest Drive and turn left (known as Algonquin Road to the right). Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class as directed by the judge to plan their strategy. Judges briefing will outline the course and answer handler questions. A warm up jump will be provided for each ring.

Ringside Exhibitors are responsible for being at ringside when it is their turn to run. Gate Stewards are only following directions to keep the trial moving smoothly for all. Please treat all volunteers working this trial for you with respect.

Classes STD, JWW, FAST & T2B Classes offered as described in Chapter 2, 10 and 11 in the Agility Regulations.

Obstacles Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility. All contacts are rubberized and weave poles are 24" spacing.

Site Information The agility trial will be held at Car-Dun-Al's training facility, 10783 Wolf Drive, Huntley, IL. The training center is in the southwest corner of the second building on the right. It will be indoors on ¾" agility matting. There will be no barking dogs allowed in vehicles; they must be crated inside. Fast food restaurants are nearby. Any additional questions regarding the site and its amenities should be directed to the trial chairman.

Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the show site clean.

Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dogs will be excused from the trial with no monies refunded.

Food Food will not be available at these trials. There are several fast food restaurants near the trial site.

Prizes and Awards Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each jump height in each Standard, JWW & FAST class and 1st place in each T2B jump height. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to place. A bar and rosette will be awarded for teams earning their MACH, PACH or PAX. Only one bar will be awarded for a run that earns both a PACH AND PAX. All prizes must be claimed before the close of the trial. None will be mailed.

Additional Awards

All regular and non-regular classes 1st - 4th - Medallion w/show logo.

1st Place: 6" plate from Oak Hill Pottery.

Every dog/handler that attains their MACH/PACH will receive a MACH/PACH rosette and MACH/PACH bar offered by Michelle O'Brien, Evenstar Siberians.

Every dog completing an Agility Title will receive a 15" rosette offered by Theresa Przybylski in memory of U-ACH, U-CD Sasha in the Snow CDX, OA, CGC Can CD, BMD CD and U-ACHX, U-CD, CH R.E.D.S. Pride of the Pack WPD, CD, RE, AX, AXJ, NF, NAP, NJP, NFP, OCC, NGC, NJC, NAC

HIGHEST SCORING DOG IN AGILITY TRIAL will receive the following:

The Kachme-Solocha-Yeti Agility Trophy. Offered by the Siberian Husky Club of America, Inc. through the generosity of members who value the great teamwork possible with our Siberian Huskies, at its National Specialty Show. The trophy will remain in the possession of the SHCA. Each year's winner will receive a photo taken with the trophy the day of the show, and their dog's name will be inscribed on the trophy base.

8" Blue & Gold Rosette with 24" long Streamers

Agility High in Trial will be awarded from the STANDARD class, including Regular and Preferred to the Highest Scoring Siberian Husky. In case of a tie in score, then seconds under course time will be weighted as follows in determining HIT. Using the following calculation, High in Trial would go to the Siberian Husky with the highest number.

Novice Preferred: Seconds under course time multiplied by 1

Open Preferred: Seconds under course time multiplied by 2

Excellent/Master Preferred: Seconds under course time multiplied by 3.

Novice: Seconds under course time multiplied by 2 with 5 points added

Open: Seconds under course time multiplied by 3 with 5 points added

Excellent/Master: Seconds under course time multiplied by 4 with 5 points added



Notice to Exhibitors

Dogs Eligible to Enter This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

No more than 10 entries allowed per envelope No online entries will be accepted. Express Mail entries (although not necessary) must waive “acceptance signature requirement”. **Entry form changes, corrections or cancellations must be done in writing before the September 19, 2018 closing date.** Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms. Entries must include the AKC agreement.

Measuring and Height Card Information When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the **Dogs To Be Measured List**.

Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24” height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor’s responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Height Divisions Judges reserve the right to measure dogs without a valid height card. Dogs **may not** enter both **Regular** and **Preferred** classes for the same set of trials for the weekend.

Dogs that run in a division lower than their proper height will be eliminated. Preferred dogs must run at their measured height.

Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this, Exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Single copies of the latest edition of the rules may be downloaded without charge at www.akc.org or ordered from the AKC online through the AKC store.

Liability No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Vet or judge or barred from the competition by act of the Trial Committee.

Collars At the handler’s option the dog may wear a FLAT or rolled leather collar but there shall be no attachments hanging or otherwise on collars. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy collars, Halties and Gentle leaders are prohibited. Food, toys and whistles or other training devices are not allowed in the course area.

Leashes **All dogs must be on leash** (with the leash in owner’s or handler’s hand; not dragging on the ground) at all times except when in the designated Agility warm up area or when in the ring being judged. Flexi leads are not recommended in crating or course area.

Catalogs Catalogs for the National are \$25.00 for Pre-Orders. Information is in the Info Booklet on the website: (<http://shca2018-il.org/entries.html>). Running Order sheets will be posted and will be available online to exhibitors for download at the **ATS** website (<http://agilitytrialservices.com/html/schedules.html>) after closing. You may print a copy in advance (if desired) in lieu of copies available during the trial weekend.

Refunds No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Vet or judge or barred from the competition by act of the Trial Committee. **No refunds are offered for sick or injured dogs or handlers.**

Withdrawals For bitches that come into season after the closing date, the entry fee less \$10.00 per day administrative fee will be refunded if a letter from Veterinarian is received by 30 minutes before the first class in which the dog is entered.

Move Ups Dogs finishing the requirements for a title may move up to the next level of competition in accordance with AKC Agility rules. Day to day move ups will be allowed. Pre-trial move ups must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary no later than 6:00 pm CDT on Monday, **October 9, 2018.**

Onsite day to day move ups will be allowed if made by the close of Saturday’s trial for the Sunday trial. Close of the trial will be considered when the ribbons have been awarded for the last class of the day. Verbal requests will not be accepted. Move up forms will also be available at the trial. If you need to move up, complete the form and on the next page and mail to:

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
