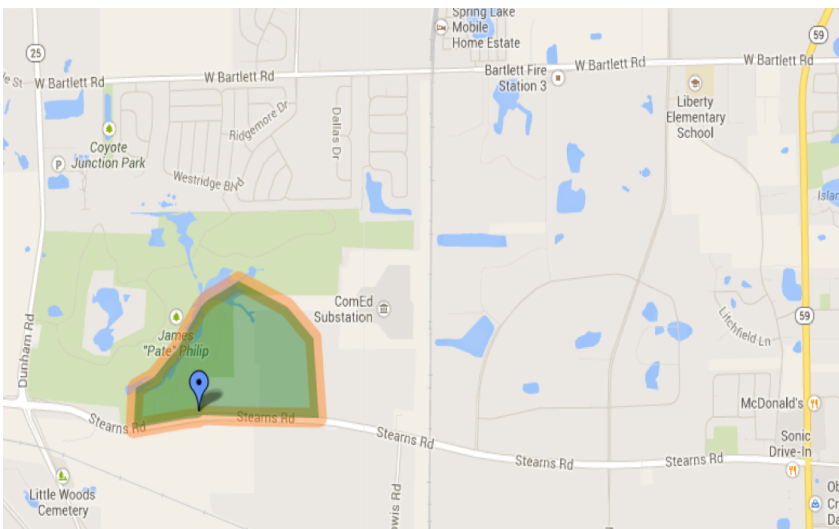


James "Pate" Philip State Park

There'll be time to walk the trails with your 4-legged (or even 2-legged) friends. If we have enough snow, we'll use sleds, or bring your skis and skijor! Dry land rigs will be used instead of sleds if there isn't enough snow. Please dress warm as this event is entirely outdoors!

or run out for some nearby fast food.

Directions:

Take IL 59 (Sutton Rd) to Stearns Rd in Bartlett. Turn onto Stearns heading west for 2.5 miles. The park will be on your right/north side (about 1 mile west of the railroad tracks). Once in the park, follow the roads to the right to get to the pavilion.



Several of us use this park for its sled trails. It is very important that we respect it and keep it clean. Please, **DO NOT** chain any dogs to trees and clean up after the dogs.
